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NFIB Endorses Julie Bunn in Race for State Representative in District 56A

ST. PAUL, Minn., Sept. 30, 2010—The National Federation of Independent Business Minnesota’s political action committee, Save America’s Free Enterprise Trust (SAFE) endorsed Representative Julie Bunn today in the race in District 56A. Previous to serving in the legislature Julie was an applied economist and also a college professor and lives in Lake Elmo.
